Balaclava One that covers your head and neck

Pants/Bibs loose fit pants that go over your

base layer

Gloves one pair light gloves and one pair heavy aloves

Hats one brimmed and one knit

SPECIFIC TO UPLAND BIRD HUNTERS

Shotgun and Shells **Hunting License**

ITEMS TO LEAVE HOME

Air Mattress or Foam Pad Sleeping bags Pillows

*Note on Boots: good hiking boots (insulated if rifle hunting) are key to comfort, make sure that your boots are broken in prior to your hunt. We recommend Montana-made Kenetrek Boots.
